- supporting in the provision of a safe, happy and clean environment
- being responsible for reporting all accidents, safety hazards or observations of children who are unwell
- meeting children's personal care needs including toileting and nappy changing
- assisting in helping the children to sleep after lunch
- ensuring all health and safety standards are adhered to
